

EXPULSION OF STUDENTS

5.34

- I. The school principal may recommend, to the Superintendent, the expulsion of any student who has committed a serious breach of conduct.
- II. The principal shall recommend to the Superintendent the expulsion of any student who has violated School Board rules which require mandatory expulsion.
- III. Proper procedures shall be followed in all student expulsion proceedings as required by Florida Statutes, State Board rules, School Board rules and District Code of Conduct.
