Reservations: Calhoun County School District reserves the right, during the entire process, to reject any and all proposals, to negotiate changes in the new scope of work or services to be provided, and to otherwise waive any technicalities or informalities.

Method of Selection: Proposals will be reviewed by the construction management review committee, which has been appointed by the Calhoun County School Board. The construction management review committee shall review and evaluate the submissions (which shall include, but are not limited to, the eight items listed below) and make recommendations to the Board as to which contractors should be prequalified. Prequalified contractors will be issued a certificate establishing the type of project, dollar amount and limits the contractor is permitted to provide by October 22, 2021.

Please respond by including but not limiting your responses to the following:

- 1. Ability to comply with Public Entity Crime Statement.
- 2. Audited financial information current within the last 12 months or verification of the contractor's bonding capacity.
- 3. General information about the construction company including location, length of time in business, and its principals.
- 4. Ability to comply with E-Verify per Florida Statute Section 448.095.
- 5. Contractor trade categories and information regarding the state and local licenses and license numbers held by the applicant.
- 6. A list of projects completed within the last five (5) years, including dates, approximate value, size, and reference name for each project.
- 7. Certificates of insurance confirming current workers' compensation, public liability and property damage insurance.
- 8. A list of all pending litigation and all litigation within the last five (5) years including an explanation of each.

The completed proposal shall be attested to and signed by an authorized officer of the company, the owner, or sole proprietor and notarized.
